In addition to the above prerequisite requirements, candidates must pass a comprehensive proctored examination, pass a complete background check, agree to be bound by the CRC® Code of Ethics and complete fifteen hours of approved continuing education on an annual basis.

Item 4 Other Business Activities

- A. <u>Registered Representative of LPL Financial</u>. Mr. Runkel is a registered representative of LPL Financial, an SEC registered and FINRA member broker-dealer which acts as a qualified custodian. Clients may choose to engage Mr. Runkel in his individual capacity as a registered representative of LPL Financial to implement investment recommendations on a commission basis. Clients may also choose to custody investment assets with LPL Financial.
 - 1. Conflict of Interest. When Mr. Runkel recommends that a client purchase investment products on a commission basis or custody assets with a particular custodian, that recommendation presents a conflict of interest, as Mr. Runkel may receive a financial benefit from LPL Financial, and therefore have an incentive to recommend investment products based on commissions or other compensation to be received, rather than on a particular client's need. No client is under any obligation to purchase any commission products from Mr. Runkel. Clients are reminded that they may purchase investment products recommended by Registrant through other, non-affiliated broker dealers, and may choose to custody investment assets through non-affiliated custodians. The Registrant's Chief Compliance Officer, James Hooks, remains available to address any questions that a client or prospective client may have regarding the above conflict of interest.
 - 2. <u>Commissions</u>. In the event the client chooses to purchase investment products through a brokerage account with LPL Financial, brokerage commissions will be charged by LPL Financial to effect securities transactions, a portion of which commissions shall be paid by LPL Financial to Mr. Runkel. The brokerage commissions charged by LPL Financial may be higher or lower than those charged by other broker-dealers. In addition, LPL Financial, as well as Registrant's Associated Persons, relative to commission mutual fund purchases, may also receive additional ongoing 12b-1 trailing commission compensation directly from the mutual fund company during the period that the client maintains the mutual fund investment. The securities commission business conducted by Mr. Runkel is separate and apart from Registrant's investment management services discussed in the Registrant's Brochure.
 - 3. Other Compensation. In the event the client chooses to purchase investment products through a brokerage account with LPL Financial, or custody investment assets with LPL Financial, Mr. Runkel may receive compensation other than commissions from LPL Financial. Other compensation may include bonuses based on production, stock options to purchase shares of LPL Financial's parent company, LPL Investment Holdings Inc., reimbursement of fees that your financial advisor pays to LPL Financial for items such as administrative services, and other things of value such as free or reduced-cost marketing materials, payments in connection with the transition from another investment firm to LPL, or attendance at LPL Financial conferences and events. These types of compensation from LPL Financial may be based on overall business production and/or on the amount of assets serviced in LPL Financial advisory programs.
